Tone 5 Troparion (*Resurrection*)

Let us, the faithful, praise and worship the Word,
co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit,
born for our salvation from the Virgin;
for He willed to be lifted up on the Cross in the flesh,
to endure death, and to raise the dead//
by His glorious Resurrection.

Tone 1 Troparion (*St. Cyriacus*)

O dweller of the wilderness and angel in the body,
thou wast a wonderworker, O our God-bearing Father Cyriacus. Thou didst
receive heavenly gifts through fasting, vigil, and prayer, healing the sick and the
souls of those drawn to thee by faith. Glory to Him Who gave thee strength!
Glory to Him Who granted thee a ^crown!//
Glory to Him Who, through thee, grants healing to all!

Troparion to Saint George : You were bound for.... Glory to The Father

Tone 5 Kontakion (*Resurrection*)

Thou didst descend into hell, O my Savior, shattering its gates as Almighty,
resurrecting the dead as Creator, and destroying the sting of death. Thou hast
delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of man, // and we cry to Thee: "O Lord,
save us!"

Tone 8 Kontakion (*St. Cyriacus*)

The sacred Lavra honors thee as a mighty champion and helper, and yearly
celebrates thy memory. As thou hast boldness before the Lord: preserve us from
our enemies//
so that we may sing: "Rejoice, thrice-blessed Cyriacus!"
