**18<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST — Tone 1. Martyr Nestor of Thessalonica (ca. 306). Ven. Nestor the Chronicler of the Kiev Caves (Far Caves—ca. 1114). Uncovering of the Relics of St. Andrew, Prince of Smolensk (1540). Martyrs Capitolina and Eroteis of Cappadocia (304). Saint Claudia Procula (1<sup>st</sup> c.). Martyrs Mark, Soterikhos, and Valentine (304).**

**Tone 1 Troparion (Resurrection)**

**When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, While the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure body, Thou didst**

rise on the third day, O Savior, Granting life to the world. The powers of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of Life: “Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Thy Kingdom!// Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou Who lovest mankind!”

**Tone 4      Troparion (St. Nestor)**

Thy holy martyr Nestor, O Lord, Through his sufferings has received an incorruptible crown from Thee, our God. For having Thy strength, he laid low his adversaries, And shattered the powerless boldness of demons.// Through his intercession, save our souls!

**Troparion you were bound for good deeds....Glory to the Father and the Son and the holy spirit.**

**Tone 1      Kontakion (Resurrection)**

As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, Raising the world with Thyself. Human nature praises Thee as God, for death has vanished. Adam exults, O Master! Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and cries to Thee:// “Thou art the Giver of Resurrection to all, O Christ!”

**Tone 2      Kontakion (St. Nestor)**

Having fought the good fight, Thou didst win immortal glory, O Nestor. Thou didst become a perfect soldier for the Master Through the prayers of the martyr Demetrius.// Together with him thou art praying unceasingly to Christ God for us all.
