**Tone 4 Troparion** (*Resurrection*) When the women disciples of the Lord learned from the angel the joyous message of Thy Resur<u>rection</u>, they cast away the an<u>ces</u>tral curse and elatedly told the a<u>pos</u>tles:"<u>Death</u> is overthrown! Christ God is <u>risen</u>,// granting the world great <u>mer</u>cy!"

# Tone 2Troparion(Sunday of Orthodoxy)We venerate Thy most pure image, O GoodOne;and ask forgiveness of our transgressions, O Christ our God.

Of Thine own <u>will</u> Thou wast pleased to ascend the <u>Cross</u> in the flesh and deliver Thy creatures from bondage to the <u>En</u>emy.

<u>There</u>fore with thankfulness we cry a<u>loud</u> to Thee:

"Thou hast filled all with joy, O our <u>Sav</u>ior,// by <u>com</u>ing to <u>save</u> the world."

Tone 1Troparion(Holy 40 Martyrs)Through the sufferings which Thy holy Forty Martyrs endured for Thy sake, OLord, we beseech Thee, O Lover of ^mankind:// "Heal all of our infirmities!"

Troparion You were bound for good deeds, O martyr of Christ: George; by faith you conquered the torturer's godlessness. You were offered as a sacrifice pleasing to God; thus, you received the crown of victory. Through your intercessions, forgiveness of sins is granted to all.

# Tone 4 Kontakion (*Resurrection*)

My Savior and Redeemer

as God rose from the tomb and delivered the <u>earth</u>-born from their chains. He has shattered the <u>gates</u> of hell, and as Master,// He has risen on the third day!

Tone 6Kontakion (Holy 40 Martyrs)You have abandoned all earthly armies,<br/>cleaving to the heavenly Master, O Forty Martyrs of the Lord.<br/>Having passed through fire and water, O blessed ones,//

you have fittingly received heavenly glory and <u>many</u> crowns.

#### **Tone 8Kontakion** (Sunday of Orthodoxy)

No one could de<u>scribe</u> the <u>Word</u> of the <u>Fa</u>ther;

but when He took <u>flesh</u> from <u>thee</u>, O Theotokos, He accepted to <u>be</u> described, and restored the <u>fallen im</u>age to its former state by uniting it to divine <u>beauty.//</u> We confess and pro<u>claim</u> our salvation in words and <u>im</u>ages.
