When the women disciples of the Lord
learned from the angel the joyous message of Thy Resurrection, they cast away
the ancestral curse
and elatedly told the apostles: “Death is
overthrown! Christ God is risen, // granting the world great mercy!”

Tone 1 Troparion *(Feast)*

When Thou, O Lord, wast baptized in the Jordan,
the worship of the Trinity was made manifest.
For the voice of the Father bore witness to Thee,
and called Thee His beloved Son; and the Spirit in the form of a dove confirmed
the truthfulness of His word. O Christ our God, Who hast revealed Thyself //
and hast enlightened the world, glory to Thee.
Troparion You were bound for good deeds....

Tone 4 Kontakion *(Resurrection)*

My Savior and Redeemer as God rose from the tomb and delivered the earth-
born from their chains. He has shattered the gates of hell,
and as Master, // He has risen on the third day!

Tone 4 Kontakion *(Martyr Tatiana)*

In thy sufferings thou didst shine brightly
in the royal purple of thy blood, and like a beautiful dove thou didst fly to
heaven,
passion-bearer Tatiana. // Therefore, always pray for those who honor thee!

Tone 4 Kontakion *(Feast)*

Today Thou hast shone forth to the word, O Lord,
and the light of Thy countenance has been marked on us. Knowing Thee, we sing
Thy praises:
“Thou hast come and revealed Thyself, //

O unapproachable Light.”
